



IFE Approved Duties of the Fire Marshal

Aims

To provide participants with a greater awareness of the threat posed by fire and the actions to be taken upon the discovery of a fire.

Target Audience

This course is designed specifically for those personnel that have a designated fire responsibility as either Fire Warden/Marshall working in industry, commerce or the public sector.

Course Objectives

At the end of the course delegates will be able to:

- Execute their duties as a fire warden / Marshall
- Understand the nature of the fire and how it spreads
- Distinguish between different types of extinguishers and their correct applications
- Tackle small fires with confidence

Course Outline

The course includes sessions on:

- Fire Safety Legislation
- The Nature of Fire & Combustion Principles
- Fire Procedures
- Duties of the Fire Warden / Marshall
- Classes of Fire & Types of Extinguishers
- The selection and use of fire extinguishers
- Practical exercise using various extinguishers

Duration

1/2 Day (3.5 hours)

Attendees should wear suitable outdoor clothing if they are to participate in the practical fire fighting exercise. Nylon, plastics etc are not appropriate materials as they may result in injury if subjected to heat extremes. Attendees who have a history of asthma should also advise the course tutor prior to commencement.
