



UKATA Asbestos Awareness

Target Audience

The course is aimed at personnel who may in connection with their normal duties come into contact with materials that may contain asbestos, as required by the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012.

It is also appropriate for supervisory / management personnel as an introduction to the subject.

The course has been accredited by the United Kingdom Asbestos Training Association (UKATA) as a Category A, Asbestos Awareness training course.

Aims

- To provide an understanding of the health effects associated with asbestos materials
- To provide the attendees with an appreciation of the new legislation
